Atlantis Resort

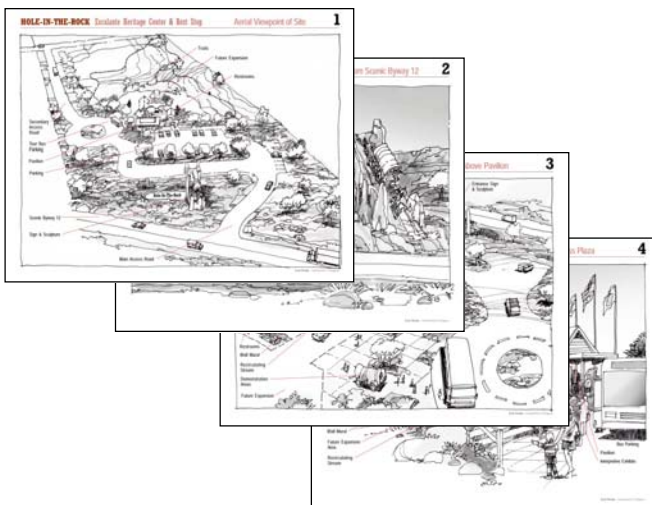
