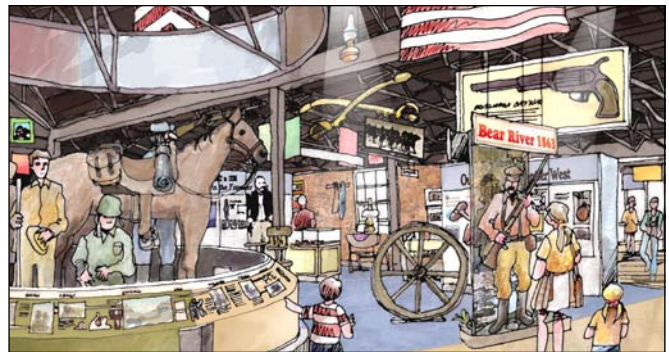




Fort Douglas Military Museum
